

P1 Enrolment

If you have a child who is due to start school in August 2017, enrolment will take place in the school during week beginning 16th January at the following times:

Parents/Carers are reminded that they need to bring with them their child's full birth certificate, along with 2 proofs of residency, such as a utility bill or a bank statement.



Scots Week

Following on from the success of our Scottish Book Week last term, the whole school will be participating in a special Scots Week starting on Monday, 23rd January. During this week children from across all stages will have the opportunity to enhance their understanding of Scots language through a range of different activities, including poetry and song. This will culminate in a special Scots Afternoon on Friday, 27th January where children will have the chance to showcase their learning to others.

Children Arriving Late At School

Please remember that parents/carers should accompany their child to the front entrance if he/she is late for school or if they arrive back at school having attended an appointment. This will then ensure that your child arrives in school safely.





Inclement Weather

It is also vitally important that you keep us informed of any changes to your contact details in case we need to telephone you in an emergency.

Wider Achievements

We are keen to celebrate children's achievements out of school at our weekly assemblies. Should your child achieve something in an activity or club out of school, please encourage them to let us know. Children are also invited to bring in any certificates, medals, trophies or badges that they have been awarded so that these can be shown to everyone in the school. We have now created a display of children's achievements out of school in our dining hall and it is great to see so many photographs already on show.





School Lending Library

One of our improvement priorities this session is to raise children's attainment in reading. As part of this, last term we opened our school lending library to P4 and P5 children and their parents/carers so that they may borrow a book that they can read at home together. This term we plan to open our lending library to all P3-7 children and their parents. Sessions will take place from Wednesday afternoons starting week beginning 16th January, so please come along and lend us your support.

Indoor Shoes

We take great pride in our school and are keen to keep all areas of our building clean. For this reason, all children are asked to change into a pair of soft indoor shoes before entering their classroom. These indoor shoes can then be worn for P.E. in the gym hall. Please note that, for health and safety reasons, children are <u>not</u> allowed to wear shoes that have been worn outside when taking part in P.E. in the gym hall.



We have noticed that some children's gym shoes are becoming so worn that they are now unsafe. If you receive a letter in your child's schoolbag informing you about this, we would be grateful if you could try to get them another pair of gym shoes as soon as possible. Thank you.



Absence

Please remember that it is a parent/carer's responsibility to let us know if their child is going to be absent from school. This can be done by either sending in a letter in advance of a planned absence, or by telephoning the school office. Should your child be absent and we are unable to determine their whereabouts, we are obliged to contact the Attendance Officer who will call at the family home.

<u>Jewellery</u>

We would be grateful if children could refrain from wearing jewellery on days when they have P.E. For health and safety reasons, children are asked to remove all items of jewellery before their P.E. lesson. If your child has just recently had his/her ears pierced and cannot remove their earrings, parents are asked to provide small plasters to cover their child's ears. Thank you.
