Dear Parent/Carer

I am aware that Christmas is fast approaching and many of you may be becoming anxious about how this will be celebrated in the school this year. Unfortunately, we will be unable to host our usual Infant Nativity and Christmas Service since we need to keep children in their class bubbles/nursery pods and, in line with Scottish Government restrictions, we are still unable to sing in groups.

### **Christmas Hampers**

In light of Covid restrictions and the recent news that South Lanarkshire will be moving to Tier 4 as of this Friday, we have decided to postpone our usual hampers at present. This is something that the Parent Council may then look to pick up again later in the session if things settle down.

### **Christmas Cards**

In light of potential cross contamination, please could we ask that children do not hand out Christmas cards in the playground to their friends. Instead, all Christmas cards should be brought into class and placed in the class postbox where they will be quarantined before distribution. Please note that children should only bring in cards for the children in their own class as we will not be able to distribute cards between different classes this session. Cards can be brought in anytime from **Monday, 7<sup>th</sup> December** till **Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> December**. Unfortunately, we will be unable to accept cards outwith these dates.

At David Livingstone Memorial Primary School and Nursery Class, staff at all levels are extremely grateful and overwhelmed by the generous gifts that we receive from families. This year more than ever, we are aware that many families are finding things extremely difficult.
