# P1- P7 Online Learning

As of Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> January, we will be moving to online learning for all classes. This will be done via Google Classroom and I am delighted to say that we now have about 95% of our P1-P7 children logged on.

Next week, a pack containing different learning activities will be posted on Google Classroom for each class. This will contain a mixture of Literacy, Numeracy and interdisciplinary learning tasks for the children. If, when you look at this pack, your child is unsure about which group they are in, please either post a message on Google Classroom, or email the school office (<u>gw14dlmpsoffice@glow.sch.uk</u>). Once a week, one of our teachers will also post up a Health and Wellbeing activity, and an RME (Religious and Moral Education) activity for your child to do.

Staff will be on Google Classroom from 9.00am till 3.00pm each day. Like we do in school, they will complete an emotional check-in with the children first thing in the morning and they will also post up comments throughout the day. Once your child has finished a piece of work, please either upload this as a document onto Google Classroom, or take a photograph of it and upload this instead. Teachers will then give the children feedback on anything that they have posted. We will be monitoring pupil participation and engagement, so please encourage your child to post up anything that they have completed. If your child posts up anything outwith school hours, this will receive a response the following day.

If you have any problems accessing Google Classroom from home, please email Miss Lattimer (Acting Depute Head Teacher) and she will do her best to help (<u>gw07lattimerjennifer@glow.sch.uk</u>). A helpsheet explaining how to access Google Classroom has also been added to our school website. In addition, we still have a few devices that we are able to loan out to families to support them with learning at home. Please either phone or email Miss Lattimer if this something that you require.



Starting on week beginning 18<sup>th</sup> January, teachers will begin posting up daily tasks for the children to do, rather than a pack for the week. This is in response to feedback that we received after the previous lockdown and will be evaluated after we have trialled this for a number of weeks.

As you know, some teachers will taking responsibility for the limited number of children that we have in school each day. These children will complete the work that has been posted on Google Classroom whilst they are in class. Teachers who are working in school will not post anything on Google Classroom during this time. However, another teacher will take responsibility for online learning at home and so your child will still be able to engage with a member of staff throughout the day, as well as ask any questions that they might have.



#### Nursery Learning Journals

During lockdown, our Early Years staff will post up learning activities on the children's online Learning Journals and we will continue to use this resource as a way of communicating information with you. Please also use your child's Learning Journal to share any achievements or successes throughout the day. Like the rest of the school, staff will comment on anything that is posted up.

# Scottish Child Payment

Scottish Child Payment is a new benefit which will start on Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021. This payment is for families on certain benefits or tax credits. Eligible families will get £40 every 4 weeks for each child under the age of 6 years.
