Children will have increased opportunities to develop their literacy skills through outdoor play. | The cost of the nursery day will reduce to £0 for all children. All children will have an SLC library membership. Resources to support the development of Literacy, Numeracy and Health and Wellbeing at home will be provided for all children. | Attachment-informed practice and the 6 principles of nurture will be evident throughout the school.
