What do we want to achieve? (Outcomes)	Develop pupil engagement in reading for pleasure. Increase the number of children achieving expected level in Reading and Writing in P4 and P7.	Develop mental maths skills and opportunities for challenge for the more able. Increase the number of children achieving expected level in Numeracy in P1, P4 and P7.	Further develop our practice as an attachment-informed, Nurturing School. Increase opportunities for pupil participation and family learning.
How will we know? (Measures)	 The reading age of almost all children will become less than 18 months below their chronological age. The combined attainment for Reading will have increased by at least 3%. Pupil engagement in Literacy will increase. Almost all children will have an SLC library membership. 	 The numeracy age of almost all children will become less than 18 months below their chronological age. The combined attainment for Numeracy will have increased by at least 5%. Pupil engagement in Numeracy will increase. Most children will report that they feel challenged in their learning in Numeracy. 	 Attachment-informed practice and the 6 principles of nurture will be evident throughout the school. At least 75% of pupils will attend at least one extracurricular club in academic session 2022-2023. Over 50% of families will engage in at least one planned family learning experience. Most staff will report that they have a more positive sense of mental wellbeing.

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
