(Measures)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The reading age of almost all children will become less than 18 months below their chronological age.• The combined attainment for Reading will have increased by at least 3%.• Pupil engagement in Literacy will increase.• Almost all children will have an SLC library membership.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The numeracy age of almost all children will become less than 18 months below their chronological age.• The combined attainment for Numeracy will have increased by at least 5%.• Pupil engagement in Numeracy will increase.• Most children will report that they feel challenged in their learning in Numeracy.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Attachment-informed practice and the 6 principles of nurture will be evident throughout the school.• At least 75% of pupils will attend at least one extra-curricular club in academic session 2022-2023.• Over 50% of families will engage in at least one planned family learning experience.• Most staff will report that they have a more positive sense of mental wellbeing.
