How will we know? (Measures)

- Year 2 of SLC's Science Skills Framework will be implemented in all classes.
- · All classes will engage in a termly STEM challenge.
- School interdisciplinary topics will be reviewed and updated.
- All classes will engage in a learning for sustainability interdisciplinary topic.
- School will have developed a Learning for Sustainability calendar of events.

- All P1 and P2 children will engage in free-flow play.
- All P1-3 children and their families will have the opportunity to engage in the 21st Century Families Play Award.
- Different play zones will be established in our school playground.
- All parents/carers will have the opportunity to engage in play alongside their child.

- Attachment-informed practice and the 6 principles of nurture will be evident throughout the school.
- SLC's Attachment Accreditation Pledges 4-6 will be achieved.
- School will achieve Nurturing Schools status.
- Emotion coaching will be implemented consistently by staff across the school.
- At least 5% of children will show an improvement in their GWA scores.

- As part of Learning Community moderation, all pupils will study an agreed text linked to equalities and diversity.
- Most staff, children and parents will have an increased knowledge and understanding of equalities and diversity.
- School will have developed an Equalities and Diversity calendar of events.
